This book was interesting in that it really took a closer look at what the vampiric traits are for the vampires in this universe. Black eyes when hungry, cold skin, silent heart, similar to Twilight vamps in these respects, but the ability to grow hair, including facial hair, skin that can be tattooed, the ability to fly by transforming one's body into scores of little bats and purple smoke, the ability to cloak oneself in shadows to remain hidden, no reflection in a mirror or ability to be photographed without a special kind of light, and the ability to have children with other "supes", but not with humans, these are things unique to this series. It is also interesting to speculate on exactly how vampires would operate as part of a wider community of humans and shifters. I loved that Aric is a

fireman, it was fun to see what job Garrett does in the human world, and fascinating to look into his past as well. I laughed when Dawn describes Garrett as a Viking vampire nerd. It was great to read in Kane's story that the Winterset Coven had a part in helping Kane In conjunction with the shifters of the other series. I love that the coven has taken two shifter mates. I would love to see the Winterset Coven and the Bloodrunner Crew put the past behind them and develop a friendly relationship in the future. I really liked how Dawn and Garrett's issues with him being a supe and Dawn being human were eventually solved. It was cool to see Dawn's character develop and find her strength, and I really enjoyed getting to know Garrett's character more fully. I think I mentioned it before, but the Viking stuff was awesome. I'm excited to learn more in "Third in the Winterset Coven". Keep them coming, T.S. Joyce, and I'll definitely keep buying and reading.
