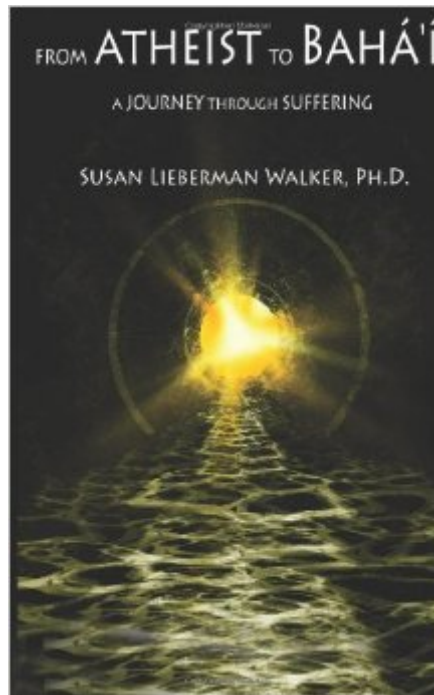

The author opens her heart to you as she shares the intimate details of her own personal journey from atheism to the Bahá'í Faith. Although the author's experiences and evolution lead her to a particular faith, her journey is universal in nature and speaks to all of us. A series of unexpected and

incomprehensible events both challenge the author's view of reality and evoke fear, uncertainty, helplessness, and deep pain. In her suffering she asks questions, looks for meaning, and seeks to understand. As she integrates her experiences and her view of reality expands, she realizes a beautiful self-transformation. Readers interested in learning more about the Bahá'í Faith will find the final section quite informative as the author shares her questions regarding the Bahá'ís as well as the intellectually and emotionally satisfying answers she received. But, again, this is an inspirational story which touches anyone who is on a journey of self-discovery.
