What a fun series! It was nice to catch up with the characters I'd met in book one, and to meet new ones! I don't have one particular character that spoke to me most, but rather, I enjoyed the contrast in personalities. My favorite part was the aliens and their worlds. I thought the author did a fantastic job with her descriptions and I was certainly intrigued by her vision of extraterrestrial life. I thought

the way she presented thoughts, telepathy, visions, and speech was helpful in my understanding of the events and conversations as well as identifying what communication was being utilized. Well done sci-fi. It's an interesting take on an old story, reinventing it to a fresh and modern adventure.

The Revenge of Excalibur is the second in Sahara Foley's Excalibur Saga. I enjoyed the story. The Revenge of Excalibur by Sahara Foley cover Arthur's daughter Pamela is the heroine of this story, though she's somewhat of a reluctant heroine. She has the same abilities of her father, which makes living a normal life on earth difficult. Pam withdraws socially because she cannot fully be herself among ordinary people who do not understand and fear her gifts when they find out. Though Arthur left to live on another planet before she was born, Pam is whisked away to save her father and his alien wife, who are the King and Queen of Calen. The Calens who took Pam to help rescue their King and Queen had to give Pam a short history of their people before she was willing to do what needed to be done for the rescue to be successful. I understood that Pam needed to know these things, but, I found that part becoming tedious and it terminated at just about that point. Pam interrupted the speakers because she too was getting tired of the history lesson. I'm not sure the author intended it to be that way or not, but, I thought it interesting that the protagonist had the same thought as I at about the same point in the story. Good timing. There is some telepathic voyeurism which I find a disturbing concept though it was part of the character development. Pam is rather immature and belligerent at first though she does step up to the challenges faced in the rescue. I did find the fixation on her love interest a little excessive, but, she's young and the unique bond that was developed explained her fixation. There is a little alien ménage taking place near the latter part of the story. I would not recommend the book for teens under 18 because of the sexual content. The character development was well done and the plot is good with a satisfactory ending, though it wasn't what I expected from the beginning.

In this sequel to The Secret of Excalibur, we get a whole new adventure with a whole new set of characters, rather than a strict continuation of Arthur, Ruth, and Daisy's story. Through a careful weaving of flashbacks into the main storyline, the author reveals what has happened to Arthur and Daisy over the course of a couple of decades, and now Arthur's grown daughter with Ruth- one that he doesn't even know exists- is destined to save he and Daisy from the torturous captivity they are enduring. The story is captivating with strange alien beings, new planets to explore and a hot & sexy hero destined to help save everyone. I liked this book even better than the first one. The characters are more believable and natural in their dialogue. It's very imaginative, entertaining and thought

provoking. I give this book a solid four stars. Great job.

Excalibur, the legendary sword of King Arthur, is hiding a dark secret. A Shalit, the most feared species on the planets Calen, Eisel and Teth, is imprisoned in the sword because the Shalit have the power to destroy worlds. However, not all Shalit are planet destroyers, but how could Pamela, daughter of Arthur, tell the difference between an evil Shalit and a good one? Which one resides in Excalibur? But to rescue her father, Arthur, and his wife, Dasiy, Pam, must release the beast inside. Fast-paced, action packed, this book is anything but boring. Although this is book 2 of the series, I was drawn into the story from the first page. I love the worlds Foley has created. They are unique and fascinating. I really liked the characterisation of Pam and Excalibur. They were totally believable and were well drawn. They propelled the story forwards, and I enjoyed reading about them. If you love fantasy based with a little bit of Arthurian Legend thrown in, then this is the book for you. I Highly Recommend.
