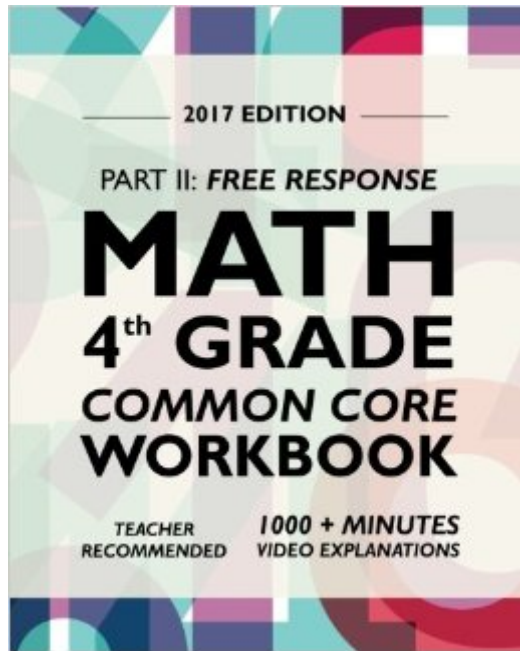


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# Common Core Math Workbook, Grade 4: Free Response, Everyday Practice (4th Grade)

I am a 4th grade math teacher and one of the most frequent questions I get from parents all the time is... "Which workbook can I use for my child to help them get extra practice?" I usually recommend the EngageNY website but when it comes to workbooks, most of the workbooks out there do a very poor job in presenting common core questions. This workbook is by far the most useful and also affordable workbook for kids to practice common core questions. Video explanations are priceless and a must use. It's unfortunate to say but many parents have a hard time to explain even 4th grade math to their child and often times kids are left helpless when they do not understand problems. The website included in the workbook comes with all video explanations so you can simply turn on the video when your child is struggling with a problem or problems. Questions are written in a similar format like the state common core math exam. There are tons of practice problems but perhaps the most useful feature for us teachers is that each question is labeled with the common core standard. I will be using this workbook along with my other usual materials for my class this September to assign students homework problems. I would highly recommend their Multiple Choice and Free Response workbook.

The Free Response book is similar to the Multiple Choice book in terms of formatting except (obviously) all the questions are free response related. Once again the video explanations are super useful and there are lots of problems to practice with. I did notice the workbook puts more emphasis on fractions which is very good because to my understanding the state exam tests a little more heavy on fractions. As written in my previous review for the multiple choice book, I would recommend this book as well. They go hand in hand and gives adequate practice questions that covers the different standards students will learn over the entire year. Common Core- Eek!

This is Part II of the the 4th Grade workbook and contains questions which require free response answers. I find this book to be an excellent way to get practice and makes it easier for my child to understand the common core concepts. The organization of the book makes it easy to practice daily by providing daily set of questions to answer. Each problem presented helps to bring out the concepts needed for understanding the common core for 4th grade and are an excellent way in reinforcing the 4th grade curriculum. I would highly recommend this book to parents to assure success in the state math exams.

Math book has, but more importantly, the explanations with the accompanying website are DEFINITELY not common core explanations. But it IS NOT what common core math is and not what the kids are being taught in school. Don't label the book Common Core, if it's not Common Core!
