

I had the impression that his book is easier to read and more organized than other books about the subject, especially if you have a Psychology background, since it's approach to the subject dosen't require a lot of Zoology knowledge from the reader, as other books on the subject do.

Decent book, but I just really hate that they don't caption the header pictures at the start of each chapter. They only refer back to them in the text but not with a (Fig.1) label or anything. It's not a huge deal, but I'd like to go into the chapter knowing why they use the illustrations they did. But other than that, I like the organization of the chapters and breakdown of material. The inclusion of stories really cements the ideas. I'd recommend buying the book if a professor says it's optional.
