Karina Halle delivers once again with this tale of two broken souls trying to heal and overcome the blows life has dealt them. The story of Keir and Jessica is one of heartbreak and redemption. Jessica has her life rocked at the beginning of the novel, and Karina Halle does a fantastic job not only depicting the scene in an honest and respectful way but also the aftermath of such events. Jessica's guilt and adjustment to a new life, while trying to fight for the man she wants, really depicts the strength of her character. Ms. Halle's development of Jessica makes her one of my absolute favorite females for her determination and fight alone. Also battling his own demons, Keir is looking for redemption to assuage his own guilt. He feels responsible for an event that has altered the life of many, and he takes steps to alleviate some of this guilt by checking on them. But more than his guilt for the said event, Keir also struggles with some events that took place while he was in the military. Even with his physical and emotional scars, his care, compassion, and ability to mix encouragement with some tough love makes me just fall in love with him. Seriously, Keir has become my favorite McGregor man. His need to protect and to care and to want to right the wrongs he feels responsible for make him a completely upstanding and honorable hero, and, let's be honest, his skills in the bedroom do not hurt. These two are truly the perfect match to heal each other - understanding, compassionate, and filled with unconditional love. Maybe it's cliché and a little cheesy, but I equate Karina Halle's writing to a box of chocolates; you never truly know you're getting. She can do intense and gripping, fun and sexy, slowest of burns or immediate connections. Regardless, I always look forward to anything she writes. The Debt is an emotional story about loss, the power of forgiveness, and the belief that broken pieces can fit together. So grab your tissues and be ready for contemporary romance at its best. "It was perfect, in the most imperfect way." I was riveted from the heart-breaking prologue; it literally starts with a bang. Jessica's life changes in only a few moments. Halle does an excellent job of capturing how most of

us would react in this situation. Throughout the book, I empathized and understood Jessica's emotions. They were so raw and heartfelt, but she had the relentless determination that I admire immensely. She's the type of woman you want as a friend or even want to be yourself. Keir, oh Keir! Halle does an excellent job with his inner dialogue as he struggles with the secrets he's harboring. It's refreshing to see a male character struggle with his insecurities. Of course he's a McGregor, so he has the sultry Scotsman act perfected. He is an understated sexy and the chemistry between he and Jessica is intense. Because of their traumatic pasts, both of them are afraid of risk and the burn is slow, just the way I love it. "We're just two broken people picking up each other's pieces."
