

It centers on criteria/info on a large number of rivers and outlines the major basins with detailed descriptions of each river, life within and alteration to the flow and course. I was amazed at how many dams have been built - only 2-3 major rivers on this continent flow unimpeded. A few maps could have been clearer (more contrasting color) but most all are great.....and many beautiful photos. My husband gave it a 5 star rating over all.
