

This is a great book to go with the video series. The author is very thorough and does a good job of describing the history and tenets of several religions in detail, as well as tips on how to relate to people with strongly diverse religious beliefs. Well done.

I think the video and teachers guide that go with this book are good, but the student guide is not much more than an outline. It just doesn't have enough detail to make it as useful as I would like.

I really like the notes in this guide. The thing I found disappointing in the E-version is that the notebook feature is not enabled. So if you want to take notes, you must do it in a separate area. If you find out differently I would love to know how to get that working!

Why not just title this little book "Comparative Beliefs" and skip the subtle self-righteousness of author Paul Carden? Instead of belittling some denominations as "Cults" Carden could be a better Christian witness if he approached this topic through a "positive" eyeglass instead of a "negative" one. I say leave judgment to Jesus Christ where it belongs.
